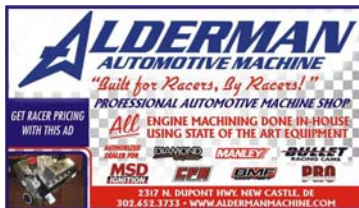
Carlisle is next week and looks like we are going to have a few come up. Should be fun.
